KEY INFORMATION

HOLIDAY QUR'AN REVISION: Parents are encouraged to establish a daily routine for **Qur'an revision** during the holiday to ensure students retain what they have memorized. Alternatively, you may contact the Management to arrange **Holiday Revision Lessons** for your child. **Contact the School HOD Qur'an at 09046548702 to register your child.**

CBT EXAMS: Our students performed better and became more familiar with the **CBT Exams** this term. The system upgrade improved network speed and user-friendliness, Alhamdulillah. While this incurred significant costs for the Management, it ensures our students remain aligned with global education standards and keeps the school **21st-century compliant**. We kindly request parents' cooperation in providing the necessary **Laptop/Android phones** for students especially as WAEC exams body is working on introducing CBT Exams.

BASIC SCHOOL RULES:

1. **School Fees:** School fees are strictly pre-paid. Parents are expected to clear all fees before resumption. While some grace is given to allow students resume without immediate payment, **this grace ends by the third week of the term**, after which all defaulters will be denied classes or sent home. To avoid any misunderstanding, we urge all parents to **do the needful** and ensure timely payment. **Kindly notify the Bursar immediately after making any bank transfers** to ensure proper record-keeping.
2. **Punctuality:** Assembly begins by 7:30am sharp. Students arriving between 8:01 and 8:15am will be required to pick up litter before being allowed into Class. Students arriving between 8:16 to 8:30am will face disciplinary action, including flogging.
3. **Neatness:** All Students must wear the complete and correct school uniform including Cap or Hijab, Socks and School Sandals and must appear smart at all time. Any incorrect or unauthorized item of clothing will be confiscated.
4. **Respect and Obedience:** Students are expected to comply with all School rules with **utmost respect to teachers** being a top priority. The use of mobile phone, speaking vulgar or inappropriate language (including pidgin English), fighting, bullying, or any form of misconduct is strictly prohibited and will attract serious punishment.

May Allah expand the provision of our parents and grant us the hearts that always appreciate Him for His innumerable favors. Ameen.

2. **Academic Excellence:** The successful conclusion of final examinations by our students, who sat for **WAEC, NECO, BECE, and Primary School Leaving Exams** with confidence and optimism—just as our previous candidates have consistently recorded outstanding results.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR NEXT TERM/SESSION

A-Textbook Policy

Parents are to make a **mandatory payment of ₦25,000** for textbook usage for the term to enable their Kids use all the textbooks required for learning. On top of this:

- **KG Classes** will receive **Mathematics and Phonics** textbooks.
- **Basic 1 & 2** will receive **English and Phonics** textbooks.
- **Basic 3 upward** will be given **English and Arabic** textbooks to take home.

Please note that students will be provided with **used copies** of these books. Parents who prefer **brand-new copies** will be required to pay the full price as stated in the official booklist.

B-New Admission Policy

To maintain the quality and consistency of our integrated academic program, **new intakes will only be accepted into JSS1 and below** starting next session, to ensure smooth adaptation. This gives learners ample time to fully adjust to our rigorous academic program and benefit from our structured curriculum.

C-Compulsory PTA Meeting

The school management has made attendance at the annual PTA meeting **compulsory for all parents**. To reinforce this policy, a **fine of N1,000** will be applied to parents who fail to attend or send any representative. As an incentive, **parents who attend** will receive a **free hard copy of the 3rd term promotional exam results**.

It is disheartening to observe a growing sense of **indifference among some parents** towards their children's academic development. Many do not review their children's performance or provide the necessary guidance at home, leaving the full responsibility to the school. This trend is **concerning and unsustainable**.

The PTA meeting provides a crucial platform to discuss key matters affecting both students and the school. We therefore **urge all parents to prioritize this event** and collaborate with us in nurturing the academic and moral success of our learners.
